INTERIM ORDER

1. The case was taken up for hearing on 07.09.2026, as scheduled, in the courtroom of the Commission.
2. At the outset, Mr. Aniket Prasoon, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner that the order of the Commission dated 25.07.2025 has not yet been complied with by HVPNL, warranting penal action under section 142, read with Section 146 of the Electricity Act, 2003. Further, no stay has been granted on the application filed by HVPNL before Hon'ble Appellate Tribunal for Electricity (APTEL). HVPNL has even failed to file compliance report directed by the Commission, in its interim order dated 11.08.2026.
3. Per-contra, Mr. Raghujeet Madan, the learned counsel appearing for the respondent Nigam, sought time to file its reply in the matter.
4. Upon hearing the parties, the Commission allows the respondents to file their compliance report / reply on or before 21.09.2026, with an advance copy to the petitioner. The petitioner is also allowed to file its rejoinder, if any, within one week thereafter with copy to the respondents.
5. The case shall be listed for arguments on 28.09.2026.
